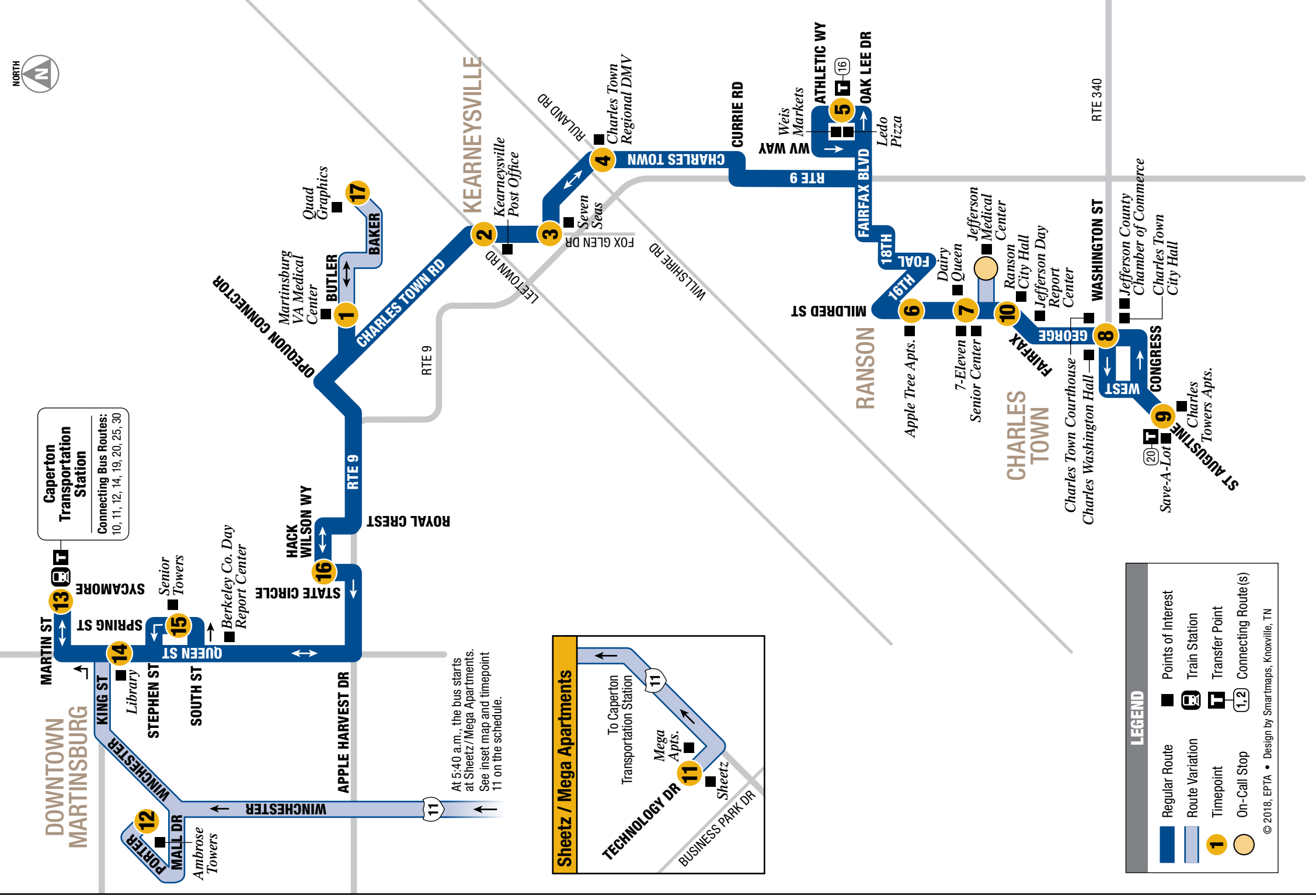

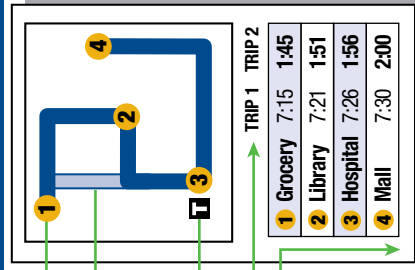

INSTRUCTIONS

Transfer points show where routes intersect and transfers to other routes may be available. The schedule shows trips from left to right in the timetable. The bus travels to timepoint locations listed from top to bottom in the timetable. These timepoints correspond with the numbers on the map.
